	<p><b>15 to 24 knots</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Good conditions for wind surfing</li> <li>- Smaller crafts may find it difficult to go out to sea. SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY.</li> <li>- May need a jacket or a wind breaker</li> <li>- Generally too windy for spraying of crops</li> </ul>
	<p><b>25 to 33 knots</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A STRONG WINDS WARNING and SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY</li> <li>- Small Tree branches breaking and destruction of plantations.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>34 to 47 knots</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- GALE WARNINGS (Damaging Gales)</li> <li>- Remain indoors and causing school cancellations and very rough seas.</li> <li>- Tree branches breaking and destruction of banana plantations.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>48 knots and above</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- STORM WARNINGS (Destructive Storm)</li> <li>- Remain indoors rough seas</li> <li>- Tree branches breaking and destruction of plantations and power lines.</li> </ul>
