### October & October to December 2024

# **Recent Observations**

#### August 2024

- Above average rainfall received over 'Eua, Nuku'alofa and Niuafo'ou. (see table below)
- The mean air temperature was 23.2°C which was 0.3°C bleow average.
- Highest 24hrs rainfall was 100.0mm recorded at Niuafo'ou on the 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Highest maximum temperature was 31.8°C recorded at Nomuka on the 19<sup>th</sup>.




The El Niño–Southern Oscillation (ENSO) is currently in neutral condition and is likely to continue during the forecast period up to early 2025.

Climate models suggest that SSTs in the central tropical Pacific are likely to remain within the EN-SO-neutral over the coming months.

#### Rainfall & Temperature Outlook: October, October-December 2024

- · For most of Tonga, rainfall in October is forecast to be normal to below normal
- During September to November, most of Tonga is forecast to receive normal to below-normal rainfall
- Maximum and minimum temperatures during October and October to December is forecast for normal to above normal across the country.
- There is an increasing trend for above normal rainfall for Tonga.



#### The next Climate update will be issued second week of October 2024 or earlier
